

Republic of Cyprus to the United Nations. Although she has no formal training as a chef, Helen learned to cook at a young age and loves to spend time preparing meals for her family and friends. This is her first book.

This book is an absolute delight! It is perfect for gift giving too. There are tons of high quality photos and the quality of paper is perfect. The point of view is also delightful (sharing a family's journey from cyprus to america). The recipes are easy to prepare and accurate. I prepare some recipes from this cookbook over and over again especially the Louvana soup (a great inspiration of yellow split pea soup which is light yet bright with a hint of sunshine from the lemmom). I also love the faggi (lentils with rice). The custard with rose water and cardamon is delicious. I would have loved to see more recipes in this book because each one is so easy and tasty. I would definitely buy this for yourself or for gift.
