I purchased Frommer's guide to Japan for a trip this spring. It not only was very helpful, but it gave me a great insight into the culture and people of Japan. This book was the exact opposite. Furthermore it contains a number of errors. For example it discusses the guards at the Islands War Memorial--they don't exist. It gets addresses wrong. Very disappointing

I agree with several of the other reviewers who've said that this is a pretty good Buenos Aires guide, but weak on the restaurants. I spent a month in Buenos Aires in early 2011 and had a delightful time in this beautiful city. I found Frommer's guide quite good overall. However, in finding restaurants, I'd suggest that you use guiaoleo dot com which has over 100,000 reviews of Buenos Aires restaurants, almost all of which are by locals. It's all in Spanish, so if that's a problem, you call always use Google Translate. Restaurants are listed by types and neighborhoods, and you can do a variety of searches.

I have always found Frommer's guides very helpful. However, I don't think I will ever use a Kindle version again. It was difficult to flip through pages to find what I needed. It is much more helpful to have the hard copy. While I love my Kindle, I won't use it again for this purpose. I would probably have given the book a 5 star rating under another circumstance.

It isn't an extremely well-designed book. It's sleek, but I find myself digging around trying to find exactly what I'm looking for. The reviews are fairly accurate, but we've had some sub-par experiences at several of the places. I guess it's the old curse of once you're recommended to tourists, you sit on your laurels and watch them stream in without trying to stay great.
