

God in Me for Little Ones 2 to 3. A weeks worth of devotions for Girls ages 2 or 3 year old. Each day has a relevant lessons for toddlers; kindness, obedience, and sharing. Colorful illustrations cover the thirty-six pages using multi-cultural drawings and names are a welcome addition for Christian materials. After each story there are three or four questions for parents to engage the child in deeper discussions. A section called Ã¢â€žâ¢"Try this!"Ã¢â€žâ¢• Gives children an activity to look at the pictures and count objects or compare characters hair and eye color; another lesson on differences and similarities. This is so important for our children today. My nieceÃ¢â€žâ¢s daughters lived in El Paso and were often intimidated being the only white children on the playground or in the day care. Now they live in SC and my niece would welcome some diversity in their play groups. Simple prayers help children talk to God. The bible verses called Ã¢â€žâ¢"GodÃ¢â€žâ¢s WordsÃ¢â€žâ¢• are short usually 3 words; easily memorized and recalled. I received this pdf free from Rose Publishing Review Program. I really like the pictures in this book and the message that they are sending. Unfortunately, much of

the words and the tone are not working for my family. We are not a very religious family, but we are very spiritual, we believe in God and we are in alignment with the preiciples of kindness and sharing, overcoming fears/trusting, and being thankful... My girls were just completely disinterested in the story. It seems to work better for us to engage more senses in our discussions rather than just telling my girls to be kind. It could be an age thing. Rather than just "do the right thing", they tend to respond to our discussions that are more like, "what does kindness feel like to you? What does it look like on someones face? How does it sound in a voice?" this engages their senses and makes them interested and then the story works. Just because God wants it is a bit too abstract for them at this age. I like that there are questions to help the conversation.
