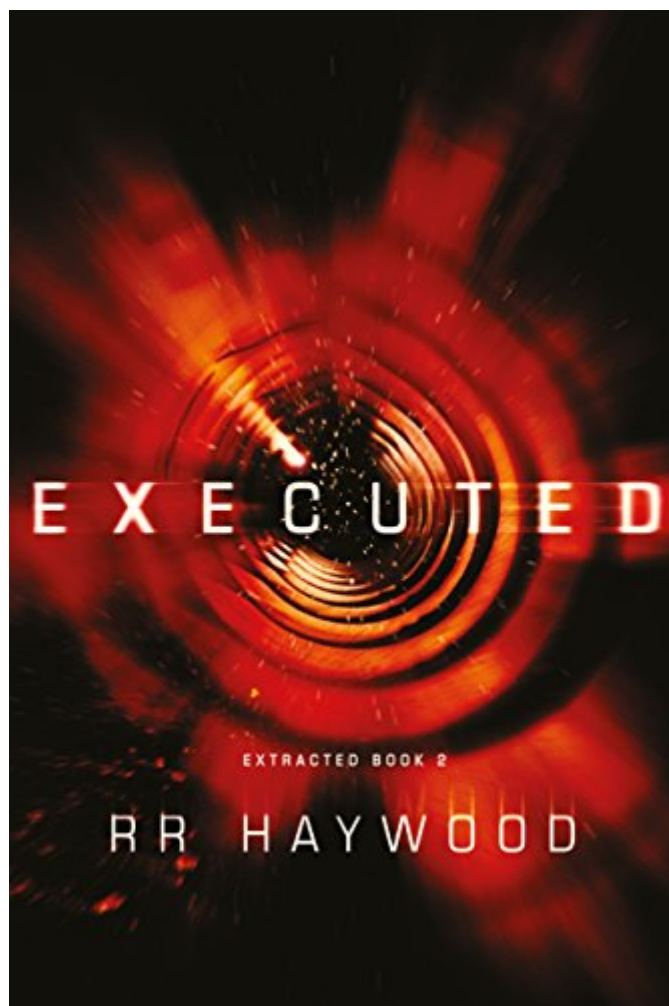


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Executed (Extracted Trilogy Book 2)

Mr Haywood has followed up his good time travel book with a better one. In this book he has had taken advantage of the ability to use this machine without getting lost in it. Without getting into details that will spoil the book, I will say it has some turns and ideas that work well. If you plan on reading this book - the first in the trilogy is an absolute must, You will be lost without it. After reading

the first book I was not sure if I would recommend it to someone, it was a bit disjointed (perhaps by design) and clearly ended like a book twice as long that was split to make you buy the follow up, I hate that. But this book makes amends - it ends without needing to read the next one. The best part is that I will buy the third book because it is a good story and not because I have been swindled into buying a book in three installments.

This is the second book in a series. I just started to read it without thinking of the first novel and was surprised when I began to recognize the characters. Almost started to delete the book, sure I had read it before. Thankfully things became clear and I read this highly entertaining novel. The author does a good job of integrating humorous thoughts/reactions into a very serious action story. I also liked the way the action was broken down into steps in a readable way. I often skip this treatment in other books. I read it while driving (as a passenger) from NJ to WV and it made the trip go very quickly! Eager for the final book in the series!

I really enjoyed Book 1 of this series and waited impatiently for Book 2. Was not disappointed. In fact, I was hooked. And Safa? Brilliant! I burst out laughing a dozen times. Storyline: very clever. Twists and turns galore. Time travel, political and psychological intrigue, heavy weapons, and awkward relationships. Perfect mix.

I liked the first Extracted book, but was a little distracted by the constantly bouncing viewpoints and the sometimes terrible over-use of sentence fragments. I also felt that a certain character's issue (Don't want to spoil anything) was given way too much screen time, so to speak, and it seemed to drag on quite a bit. Still, it entertained me enough to buy the second book, and am I glad I did. Executed is FANTASTIC. The several new major characters are awesome (especially Emily), the entire book has a lighter tone, and it's a page turner from start to finish. A great over-arching plot runs throughout the book, but there are plenty of smaller side-plots, and they all seem to just hit to make it a thoroughly entertaining read. I can't wait for the third book!
