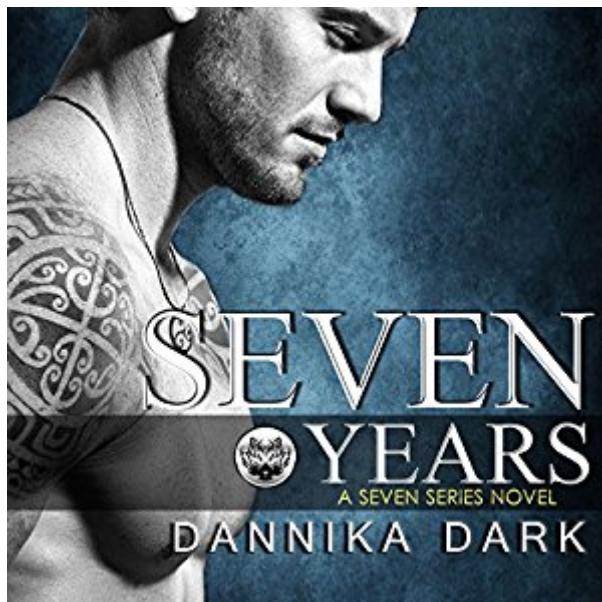

I really enjoyed the Mageri series, all of them (which is practically unheard of for me!) so, naturally I have followed Dannika with her next series Seven Years. I have thoroughly enjoyed this book with its thrills, spills, romance, family. I was captivated entirely throughout this book, and just about to start Six Months. I am thinking that I should stop writing my reviews after midnight when I have just finished the book though, as they make sense at the time... In next morning, not so much.

I have to preface this by saying I love The Mageri Series by Dannika Dark and I was unsure if this new series would live up to my expectations. Luckily, it did! You don't have to read The Mageri Series to read this book, but I liked having some base knowledge of the Breed world. The main characters/storyline follow the shifter Breed, which is a different take than The Mageri Series. I was

pleasantly surprised at how quickly I was drawn into this story. Read it in less than 24 hours-had a hard time putting it down. I loved how the author captures each character so well and I can't wait to see where this series goes. I highly recommend it!

If you haven't read any of Dannika Dark's books, I EMPLORE you to start! Yet again, her amazing writing did not disappoint! It was the perfect combination of a story that I couldn't put down, exceptionally witty banter that I've grown to love from all of her characters, twists and turns that you don't always expect, the perfect romance, and the men! Oh, the men! Those men NEVER disappoint! And this book has quite the selection of men, for every girl's taste. I cried from sadness, happiness and even cried from laughter a few times. I adored the story of Lexi and Austin. Going back periodically to remind us what they were like growing up together, and coming back to current day and finding how their past effects the present was so well written. It was often so heartfelt, and yet sometimes a little funny. It's hard to say how moving the story was without giving away too much, but I think it's safe to say it's one of my favorite stories so far. Lexi herself is an amazing woman, balancing a job that she cares deeply about, being almost a second parent, along with her mom, to her little sister (also incredibly heartwarming), an ex that's not ready to let go, all the while receiving blow after blow of life-altering shockers. She just rolls with the punches. Then there's Austin and his brothers. This is where to insert *sigh*. They aren't just brothers; they are also their own pack. They are each incredibly individual, and you would think that combination would explode, but it could not be more opposite in this case. They are incredibly devoted to each other, Lexi, and Lexi's family. I can't even count how many "awww!" moments I had, for wide ranging reasons. I LOVED each brother! Especially Austin, and one that throughout the book showed the most adorable sensitive side that would make any woman fall in love with him immediately. We also meet other shifters along the way, and they too have incredibly individual and varying personalities. Even when you don't think you'll like them, you suddenly find that you REALLY do. I know I keep saying it, but Ms. Dark has such a unique way of making her characters so incredibly individual, yet by the end of the book, I felt like I knew the heart and soul of even those that we only saw for brief moments. This was yet another wonderful beginning to the start of a new series in the Breed world that was created in her Mageri series, although a completely different view from the view we get in the Mageri series.

If I could give this book 10 stars, I would. I can't wait to read the next in this series, and find out what happens in the lives of ALL of these characters!
