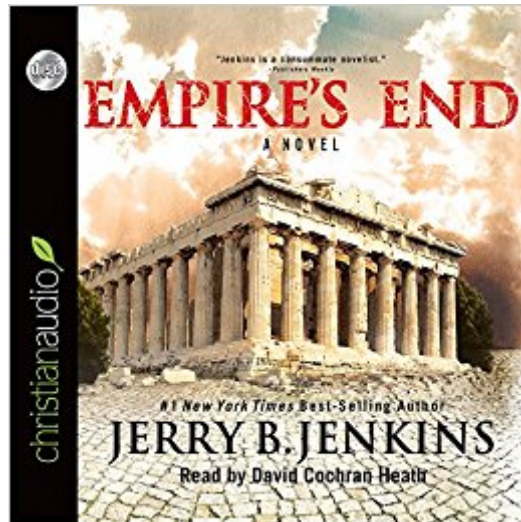

I, Saul's ending left the door wide open for Augie's journey to continue and I believe that most readers were eagerly expecting that journey, interlinked with Saul's journey in the past, to continue. I, Paul, i.e. Empire's End, however, is solely about Paul's journey (in the past), which - and on this point I have to agree with other critics - leaned too far into the realm of fiction. Whilst I believe that Jerry B. Jenkins is a talented writer, in my opinion he failed with Empire's End. I can unfortunately not recommend this book.

As always Jerry Jenkins is never boring as he brings to life the characters in his novels. He makes the apostle Paul seem human as he faces incredible trials and suffering.
