

From the public splendor of Louisiana State University to the meticulous care taken to restore the Rabalais House, this gorgeous book pays homage to the architectural jewels of one of the nation's most remarkable cities. Sweeping photographs of each grand edifice accompany histories of the address and its residents. Details of architectural features are highlighted. Each structure is both a product of its era and a reflection of later cultural influences. Buildings representing the Greek Revival, Colonial, Gothic Revival, and Queen Anne styles are displayed in this slice of Baton Rouge's diverse heritage. This gorgeous coffee-table book showcases the unique spirit of this Southern gem. Jim Fraiser is the author of fourteen books about the history, architecture, and culture of the Deep South, including *The Majesty of Mobile*, *The Majesty of the Mississippi Delta*, *The Majesty of*
