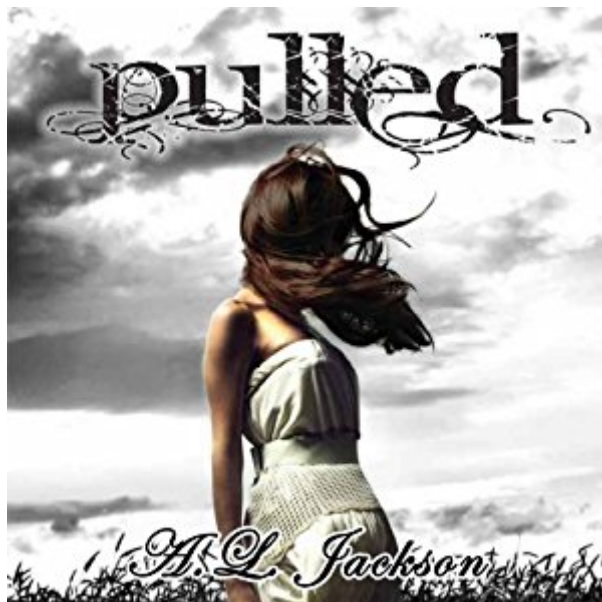

She was just seventeen when their car is hit by a drunk driver and she loses their tiny child. Her mother takes her away from Daniel thinking that she needs to heal away from the boy who got her pregnant and the loss of her baby. Melanie tries to tell her mother that she only wants Daniel, but the threat of Daniel being jailed for rape stops her until she is eighteen. Returning to Colorado she goes to the house Daniel had bought for her and finds another girl in her place. She leaves and never sees Daniel again.

That connection that Daniel and Melanie share is so palpable and immeasurable that you can literally feel the pull as you read. This is what I want and expect when I read romance. The things

they experience during those broken years, and the months and months of separation did nothing to dim the incredible connection they shared. It was such a warmth in your heart.
