

52 Fun Things to Do on the Plane is from a card deck series designed to inspire creativity and offer an alternative to the idiot box (see 52 Great Books to Read and 52 Special Traditions for Family and Friends). This particular deck, small enough to tuck into a purse or backpack, is aimed at families on the go, and includes games and activities for kids of all ages. Each card shows an illustration together with the name of an activity; the flip side has instructions. For example, one card suggests starting a round-robin story about a trip: "With another person, start telling a story about taking a trip. After a little while, let the other person continue the story and then a little later, you can continue again." The suggestions are perfect for situations in which movement is limited and you have time to while away. --This text refers to an out of print or unavailable edition of this title.

They are boxes of 52 playing-card-sized ideas cards for kids (and others). I've used them with children ages 3+, mainly ages 6-10. I am a scientist and very picky about these things. These sets are both fun and educational, and great jumping-off points for further exploration.

It's a tiny box that can fit in your purse. It has nice ideas of fun things to do on a plane.

These cards are filled with good ideas and reminders of what it takes to find the right person. It's easy to get into a rut but these cards have ideas on how to get out of the house more and hopefully put yourself in a situation where you'll meet someone. These cards are well worth the money to give yourself a boost especially if you've been out of the dating scene for awhile.

My wife is a middle school science teacher and some of these cards will be cool options for her experiments.

This set of things to do is in the format of a deck of mini cards, each of which contains a different Chicago experience. While there is certainly plenty of choice in this product, the content is very ordinary except for the traveler who has never been to Chicago before.

I sent this as a gift to a really stressed out person. She enjoyed it immensely. It contains easy little things you can do to decompress for at least a short time without any real effort. Great find!

The sleepytime cards are a terrific idea! I first read of the cards in a review on the best-seller-newest books and top ten list for children in our St. Louis POST-DISPATCH. My only complaint is that the 4 decks of cards I ordered were shipped along with my order of 3 bottles of Back to Basics Shampoo. The bottles were not sealed on their spouts with waterproof tape, thus leaking into the package containing the 4 decks of cards. These cards are intended as gifts to Mom's of little ones. One cardboard box was damaged. Thankfully the deck of cards in each cardboard box were sealed in plastic and O.K. after I wiped them dry. I sent a complaint to back when the shipment was received and have heard no response. Overall, the cards are a great idea.
