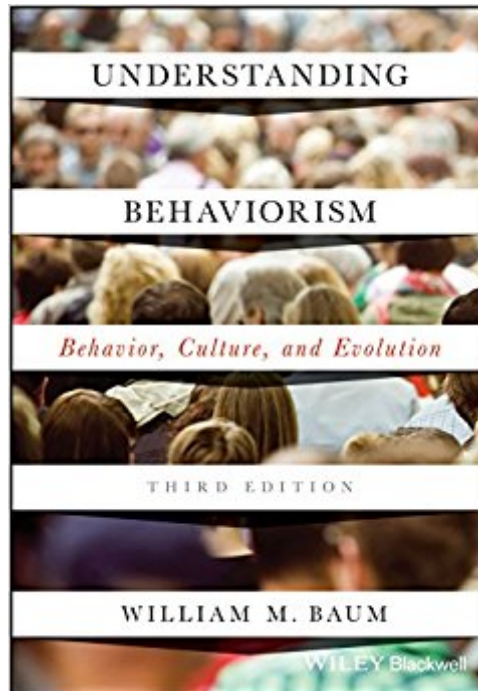

This is a comprehensive textbook about behaviorism--its relation to science and psychology, its history, its impact, and its future. Baum gets detailed and in-depth, though the book leaves me wishing textbooks didn't have that "textbook" feel. This took me back to college, and not necessarily in the most pleasant way. I'm sure textbooks are laid out and designed the way they are for a reason (hopefully because it works, and not just precedence), but what is thoroughly engaging information comes off dry and hard to swallow. Baum even injects wisps of personality here and there, so rare for textbooks; but the layout and barrage of information fall into the typical trap. I'm sure students of psychology will find a lot to take away here--3 stars isn't a bad ranking, remember. But speaking more as a reader who just wanted to learn, and as someone who read his fair share of collegiate texts, this book made me long for a textbook that didn't feel like a "textbook." Because if anyone with any subject could pulled it off, I feel like it would be Baum and behaviorism.

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
