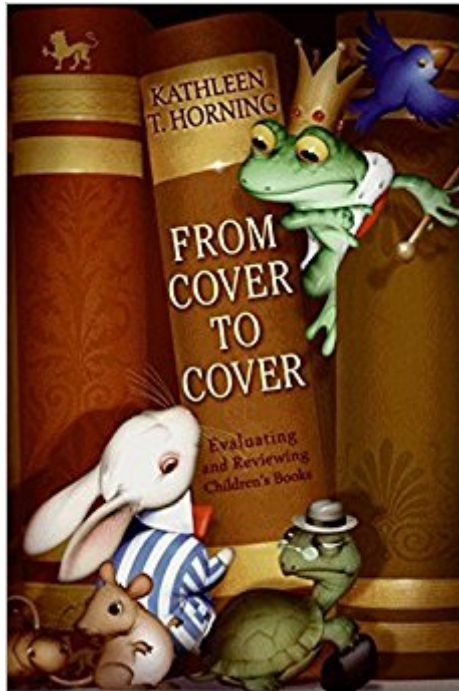

Kathleen T. Horning is the director of the Cooperative Children's Book Center of the School of Education at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. She was also a children's librarian at Madison Public Library for nine years. Ms. Horning was the president of the Association for Library Service to Children of the American Library Association in 2007, as well as president of the United States Board on Books for Young People in 2003. She has chaired or served on a variety of children's book award committees, including the American Library Association's Award, the Charlotte Zolotow Award, the John Newbery, USBBY's Hans Christian Andersen Award, the Coretta Scott King Award, the Mildred L. Batchelder Award, the ALA/ALSC's Notable Children's Books, and the NCTE Lee Bennett Hopkins Award committees, and she was selected to deliver the 2010 May Hill Arbuthnot Honor Lecture. She

is the coauthor with Ginny Moore Kruse of *Multicultural Literature for Children and Young Adults* and of *CCBC Choices*, an annual publication reviewing the best books for children and young adults. She has a BA in linguistics and a master's degree in library and information studies, both from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

In the 12 years since the first edition of this guide was published, much has changed in the children's book world. The second edition acknowledges this through updated book titles and commentary and by including subgenres in the chapter on fiction. One thing that has not changed, however, is the usefulness of this beautifully written how-to manual, which also manages to present a treatise on what is best in children's literature and why. Following an initial chapter on the construction and publication of children's books, subsequent chapters treat informational books, folk and fairy tales, poetry and verse, picture books, easy readers and transitional books, and fiction. The final chapter deals with crafting a review. The chapters on genres give ample tips on telling a well-written, well-composed book from a less-excellent specimen. The chapter on reviewing covers the distinction between reviewing and criticism and then takes a soup-to-nuts approach to preparing and composing a review. An excellent resource for any reviewer, this has special application for libraries serving information schools and for school districts that maintain in-house reviewing programs. --Ann Welton
