

The Mess Detectives and the Case of the Lost Temper is an I Can Read book by Karen Poth. This Level One book is around 32 pages and each page has around three to five lines on each page. The story is the adventure of Bob and Larry as detectives who investigate the case of a door slammer. The book follows Bob and Larry as they solve the problem of being annoyed with each other. As a homeschool mom of seven and a former reading teacher I can say I have sat through hundreds of beginning reader books. The story did not seem as contrived to me as other beginning reader books I have read over the years. The story successfully solved a problem in a natural way with limited vocabulary and sentence length. The pictures are delightful and engaging. I can recommend this book for beginning readers. The storyline of the book is Bob and Larry from "Veggie Tales" are detectives, and looking for someone who keeps slamming doors. As the villain eludes them, Bob gets more and more frustrated. In the end, they learn that it was only the wind slamming the door, but as Larry pulls his goofy stunts (like dressing up in a chicken costume when Bob tells him they need to wear a disguise to stake out Mr. Carrot's house), Bob gets more and more frustrated, and closer to losing his temper.

The Mess Detectives and the Case of the Lost Temper is an excellent book for the first reader level 1. There were very few words I had to help my 2nd grader with. The message is perfect for us right now because we are working with B on his temper as well. He stopped reading and said "TEMPER! Like on my behavior chart?!" This story hit home and is helping him slowly as we work with him on this issue and on his 2nd grade reading. B's Response: I like it best at the end when Bob is happy and not tempered.
