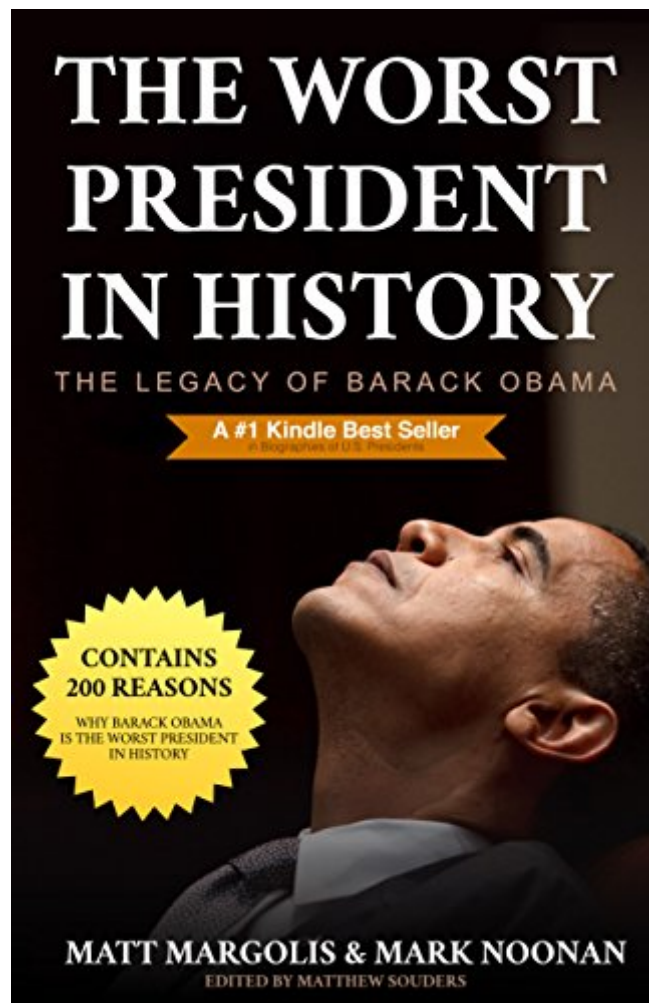




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The Worst President In History: The Legacy Of Barack Obama

The reviews are an interesting reflection on the accuracy and painstaking documenting of the book. Those who claim racism and worthlessness have clearly not bothered to read this book with an open mind - if they read it at all. Granted, it's painful reading. The footnotes are exhaustive and extensive. It was exhausting to read, and depressing. Margolis has put forward a very well written exposition of the issues facing both Obama and this Country during his presidency. All you have to do is follow the media - granted not always the main stream media - to determine the accuracy of the allegations. If Obama's aim is to destroy the USA as a democratic, flourishing country, this book tells how he has gone about it. Is it racist to tell truth? This book has nothing to do with race, except perhaps to illustrate how this president has damaged race relations in this country and made a mockery of what should have been a very proud moment in our history - election of a man based not on his race, but on his principles. Unfortunately we seem to have ignored his clearly articulated goals and elected him based on the color of his skin. We need to evaluate him on the quality of his character and the actual actions he has taken. As the mother in a racially mixed family, I find the cry of racist both offensive and pathetic.

It's interesting to note that the none of the attacks on the book succeed in undermining the assertions stated therein. Roger Scruton, in his recent book "Fools, Frauds and Firebrands," does a magisterial job of explaining why the left refuses all criticism, and sniffs in condescension at its enemies. They're on a mission against "injustice, inequality and unfairness." How can they possibly be wrong about anything if their heart is in the right place? Even though no leftist government has ever eradicated "injustice, inequality and unfairness," and indeed without exception has demonstrably made those problems worse, the left has succeeded in appropriating the terminology of moral superiority, and that's all they really want. While the right candidly admits that the flawed human heart meanders its way to a better world in fits and starts, the left insists that utopia is just around the corner, if only the recalcitrant masses would get in line and follow the program, which

always turns out to be a program of naivete and a recipe for disaster.

I waited before writing this. I deliberated for quite a while before giving it five stars. It deserves five stars for the effort the author went through to document the story alone, not to mention the research. I deliberated because it was not a pleasant book to read. Much like the attack on the World Trade Center it is difficult to relive. The book itself is well assembled and properly presented, it is just painful to look at the ugliness of his presidency and the damage he and his crony's did to the American people and our country.

The best political book I have read this year. It's also a great reference for anyone who wants a rundown of everything that has transpired during this era of "Hope and Change" that is (soon to be "was") the Obama Regime. This book is important because the media deliberately ignored most of the events that reflected negatively upon Obama, choosing to disappear those down the memory hole.
