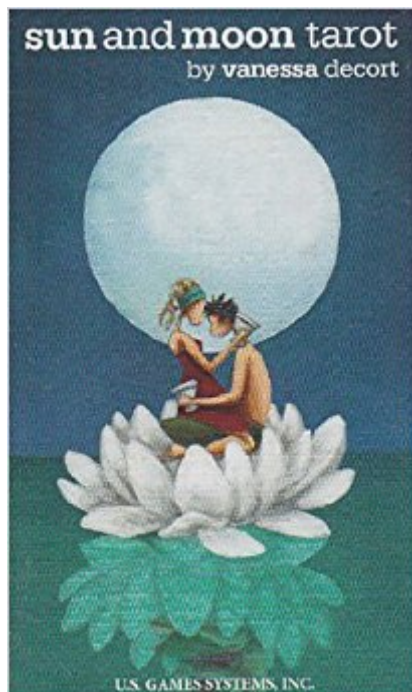

These cards help me to level my head and bring balance to my life. They help myself think about my life in a creative new way. Helps me lower my anxiety and reign back in my overactive mind.

I have to say this deck is awesome. It's really grown on me! I'd previously used my tattoo tarot deck as a go to but since picking this one up I barely use it. I really love how the artist left every person without a facial expression. I found this extremely powerful to be able to CREATE/VISUALIZE how the events surrounding the person made them feel. That is my favorite detail of this deck- it leaves room for you! My husband is not into tarot at all but he likes this deck when I read for him. He finds the art inviting. I would not recommend for beginners as some cards I otherwise know instantly do not quite give the same energy as traditional tarot in this deck. But it's only a few cards!

I got these for playing games like Gnostica and Zarcana. They seemed like "the cheapest good Tarot deck". But they are more than worth the asking price. The cards are sturdy, high quality, and slightly glossy. Suits and card types have consistent aesthetic themes and evocative art. All the suits and major arcana are true to tradition, and all the indexes are printed in whitespace outside the

art for easy reading. So, these cards are very useful for more than just divinations. I compared several Tarot decks before settling on these, and have no regrets.

Love love love this deck. I have been read with it many times and every time it connected with me more than other decks. After eyeballing buying it for months, I broke down and bought it. Immediately connected with reading this deck and it is in my top favorites. I like the astrological additives as well.

This is simple tarot deck, more towards beginners such as myself. The pictures are different from the typical tarot. I'm still connecting with the deck and its picture. So far I like it. The pictures are simple, sweet, and welcoming. I see it as a friendly deck.

These cards have the most beautiful, simplistic artwork. I am a big fan of the RWS traditional deck, but this is by far my favorite. It's like having a modern art collection in my pocket. My favorite bit is that the characters in these cards a) have no facial features, and b) appear to be a variety of ethnicities. Excellent tarot deck to own.

The images on the cards are TOO small to capture detail meanings. Each card has a visual atmosphere, but lacks enough sensual stimulation to conduct a comprehensive reading.

I love this tarot deck. I am a beginner and it really made the cards "click" for me. I can look at the card and understand the meaning right away instead of running for my notes to decipher it. I noticed that some reviewers complained about the lack of detail on the card but it helps me not to be overwhelmed by too much imagery. Also since I am a bookworm I am used to "filling in the blanks" with my imagination and I think this deck helps me do that. I feel like I get a better perspective by using my senses to feel what a certain card is telling me. My favorite part of this deck is that the positive cards give positive vibes and the negative give negative vibes. I've tried a couple of different decks before and never felt that the very positive cards gave off a good vibe. I never really noticed the difference until I got this deck and I looked at my previous decks and felt the lack. All in all I would highly recommend this deck. I think it is beautifully made!
