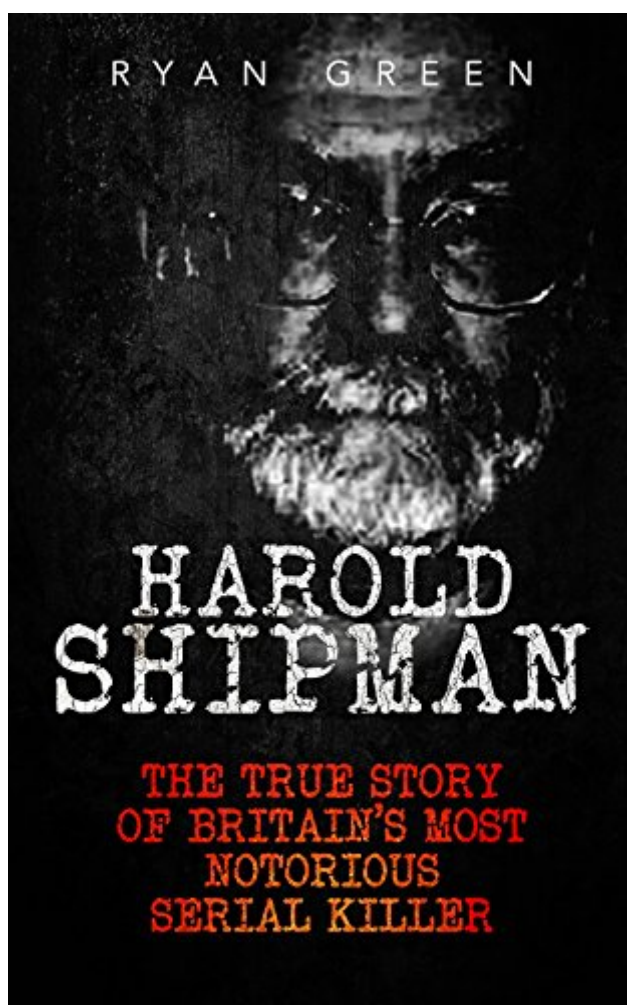


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Harold Shipman: The True Story Of Britain's Most Notorious Serial Killer (True Crime, Serial Killers, Murderers)
