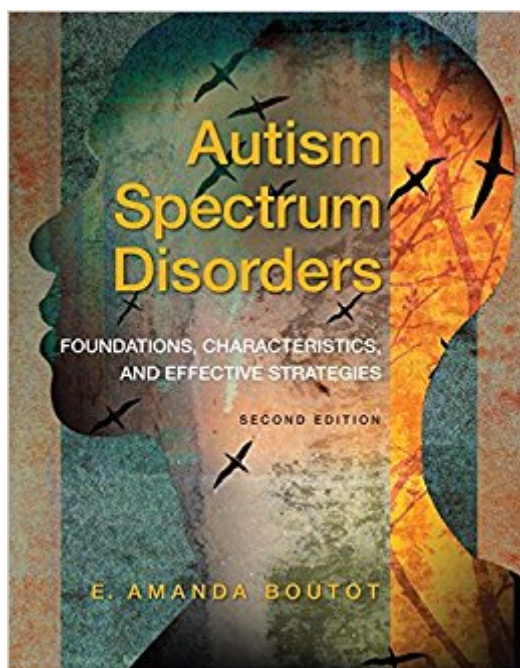

Two hours spent online with Pearson technical support resulted in them giving me several different new access card codes. One finally worked, but then linked to a "Retired" unavailable website. The Pearson supervisor eventually told me that the etext site no

longer exists so I am out of luck and should request a refund for the book. However, if you are just looking for the paper "loose leaf" version, this will work just fine for you.
