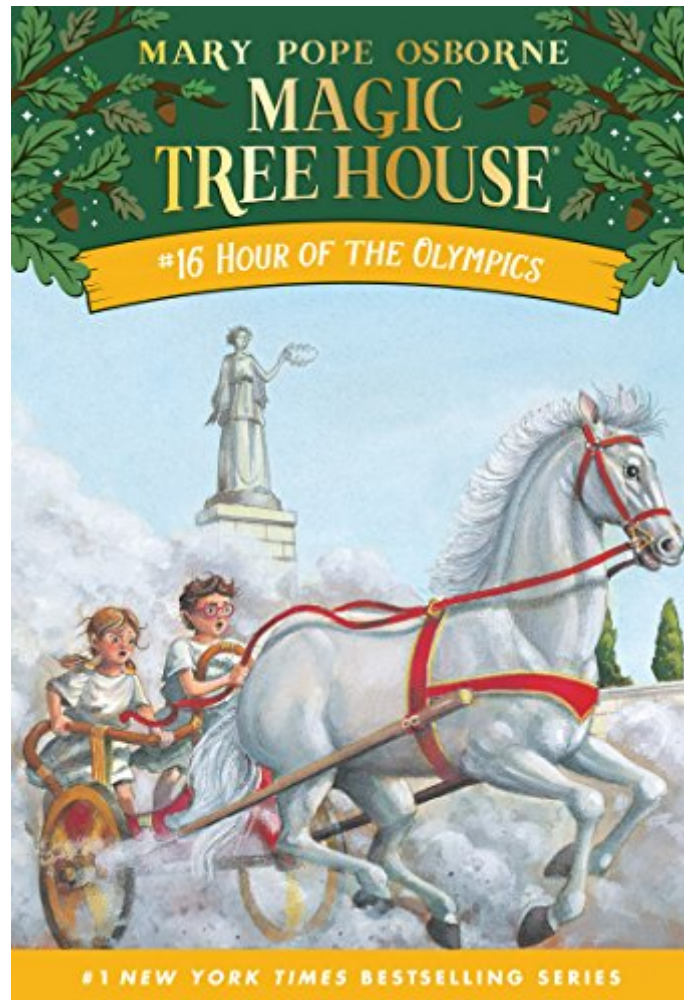




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Hour Of The Olympics (Magic Tree House Book 16)
