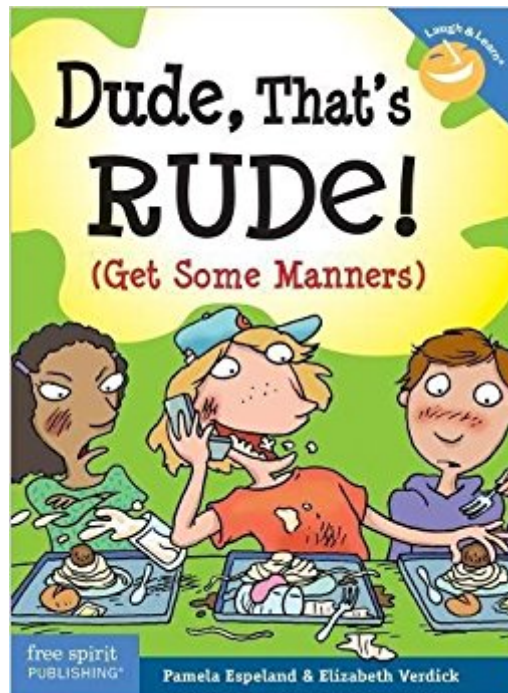

I was hoping for a better ratio of pictures and storytelling compared to a kind of kid's guide book. I can't see older students who would be capable of reading this book (ages 8 or 9 and up), pick it up and read it on their own and learn the messages, but it's also challenging to read aloud to students because there isn't really a story line and not enough pictures to support the text for non-readers. However, it will still find its use and home in my office at school.

Great book! The author did a great job teaching manners in a way that is engaging and comical yet still helpful. When it first came in the mail, my daughter saw it and wasn't interested in reading it. Then the other day I found her reading it. Now she says she likes it. I wish more kids would read it. Adults too!

I love this book because it is divided into easy to read and work through chapters. I can jump right to a section I need easily. It is funny and keeps the kids attention. I use it in lessons (I am a school counselor) all the time and the kids are always engaged. It is a great book to help cover some topics that could be tough in a way kids understand and can relate to.

This book provides no nonsense information about expected and unexpected social behaviors, but keeps it light enough for you and your young audience/child/students to actually enjoy learning a little civility. This is a great book for kids, kids learning groups, parents, babysitters, classrooms....just an excellent read and resource.

The illustrations are funny and colorful. It is a fun way to teach manners. My children have actually enjoyed reading it and so have I.
