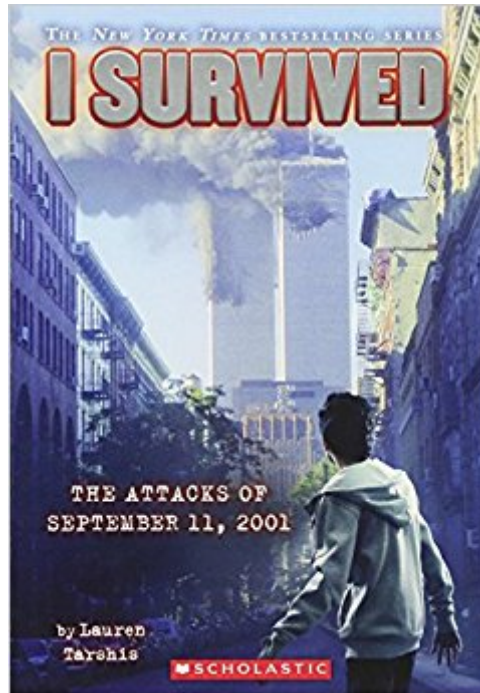

This is a great Historical Fiction series that tells about kids experiencing historical events from a personal perspective. My daughter has read many in the series and knows a lot about History, simply from reading these books. They are engaging and suspenseful while imparting factual information in a context that kids can relate to, and (more than likely) remember when memory recall is needed for information about the specific events. I highly recommend.

My second grader loves the I Survived series. I read him a few chapters each night. A great introduction to Geography and history.

My son is 9 and hard to get him to read sometimes.... Until he finds a good book. He couldn't put this book down. He finished it and said , "best book ever " .. This book is the second in the series he has read and loves them. I just ordered three more of them. :)

I bought my nine year old daughter the full series and she loves the books. She has read them all two to three times and shares them with her classmates as they take turns taking them home to read. She talks about the events all the time and how amazing it is that the people survived and has intrigued her interest more with the types of natural disasters that occur and incidents of mass casualty such as the sinking of the Titanic. Great books.

My 9 year old who's birthday is 9/11/07 was very curious about the 9/11 attacks. I struggled finding a book that would be age appropriate and something he could actually read and would keep his interest. This book did a great job at both and I enjoyed reading it with him. We donated it to his classroom afterwards.

I read this story to my 5th graders. Their generation doesn't seem to have a grasp for the horror of this event. They loved the story and want me to read more to them from this series. Several have

checked out other books in this series from our school library.

This is a wonderful series of books for junior aged kids. Our library had only one in the series and one of the middle school kids requested one which we didn't have. I hate to have an incomplete set of books so I ordered the rest and they arrived in excellent condition and are already checked out!

My children (7&9) love these books. We use them in our homeschooling. They provide a great mental picture of some historical events and helps make it 'real' to them!

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
