

This 4-in-1 collection combines titles from Barbour's Sisters in Time historical fiction series for 8-12-year-old girls. Including Maureen the Detective (age of immigration, 1903), Maria Takes a Stand (women's rights, 1914), Carrie's Courage (battling bigotry, 1923), and Anna's Fight for Hope (Great Depression, 1931), American Progress teaches both history and Christian faith.

Norma Jean Lutz began her professional writing career in 1977, when she enrolled in a writing correspondence course. Since then, she has had over 200 short stories and articles published in both secular and Christian publications. She is also author of five published teen novels. JoAnn lives on the Minnesota prairie which is a setting for many of her stories. Once a full-time CPA, JoAnn now spends most of her time researching and writing. JoAnn has published historical nonfiction

books for children and several novels with Barbour Publishing in the *Heartsong Presents* line as well as the *American Adventure* and *Sisters in Time* series for children. Several of her novellas are included in CBA bestselling anthologies by Barbour Publishing. JoAnn's love of history developed when she worked at an historical restoration in North Carolina for five years. She enjoys researching and weaving her fictional characters' lives into historical backgrounds and events. JoAnn believes that readers can receive a message of salvation and encouragement from well-crafted fiction. She captures and addresses the deeper meaning between life and faith.
