

Young children may like the show's vintage songs and corny jokes; others will yawn at its slow pace. The performance takes place in-the-round in an air-conditioned theater. You sit on a bench. Perched above the audience, birds sing "Let All Sing Like the Birdies Sing," "The Hawaiian War Chant" and "The Tiki, Tiki, Tiki Room." Flowers warble from hanging baskets; tiki statues come to life on the walls. Hosting the revue are four macawsGerman Fritz, Mexican Josf, Irish Michael and French Pierre all stereotyped beyond anything that would be created today: the show begins with Josf waking up and complaining that "my siestas are getting shorter and shorter." Two toucans recount how they migrated to the Tiki Room from the Jungle Cruise in the show's vintage preshow, which takes place alongside the outdoor waiting area. As Claude, voiced by Sebastian Cabot, Mr. French the butler on the 1960s sitcom "Family Affair" tells the story, his friend Clyde supplies the sounds of an elephant, lion and lurking crocodile ("Lurk! Lurk!"). Disney's first robots. Conceived by Walt Disney as a restaurant with a coffee bar in its center, the Tiki Room became a show before it debuted at California Disneyland in 1963. Its new AudioAnimatronics technology stunned audiences, as hundreds of tiny movements in its birds, flowers, and tiki idols were synchronized to its audio, and triggered by hidden pneumatic valves that opened and closed at the perfect timescreating a lifelike effect that seemed almost real. EPCOTThe American AdventureElaborate American history lesson is thoughtful, inspiring *****This elaborate theatrical show embraces the triumphs of the United States and the optimism of its people, but doesn't shy away from its flaws and challenges. Ben Franklin and Mark Twain tell the American story from the Pilgrims through World War II, with help from George Washington, Thomas

Jefferson, Will Rogers, Rosie the Riveter and other Audio-Animatronic figures. Film segments, a combination of photos and paintings, pan across scenes in the way later made famous by documentarian Ken Burns. Included are moments from our past both sterling and shameful.

Chatting with Franklin, Twain says, "You Founding Fathers gave us a pretty good start" [but then] a whole bunch of folks found out that "We the People" didn't yet mean all the people. Subsequent scenes portray slavery and the persecution of Native Americans.
