


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Your Endowment

I felt like this book was too high level to help me broaden and deepen my understanding of the

covenants, symbolism and ordinances of the temple. However, I highly recommend Mark's Shields' other book "Your Covenant", along with "Understanding Your Endowment" by Cory Jensen and "Understanding the Symbols, Covenants, and Ordinances of the Temple" by Amy Hardison. Those three books will part the curtain on the profound symbolism and eternal truths communicated in the House of the Lord. They do so in a reverent and sacred manner, teaching from the scriptures and drawing on the wealth of information from scholars on Ancient Near East customs.

This is for the LDS community. I actually haven't finished reading the book because I have gone back and reread many of the chapters--even starting from the first chapter once! There is so much in it to ponder and consider--and my brain doesn't work like it used to so I have to reread if I want to remember.
