It's huge and easy to read. No excessive roads listed (no back farm roads) to confuse the traveler to attempt dangerous roads even in good weather. In my rural area, this summer and this winter two semi-tractors with trailers have traveled a particular back road and gotten stuck facing certain death or destruction if their truck went into the ravine....when they attempted to turn toward their destination, instead of traveling as the goat trail met the main road and backtracked a few miles to find a location to get turned around. Everyone needs to have paper maps whether like this or printed out routes. GPS is not always accurate as it cannot distinguish between accessible roads and 'goat

trails'. I plan to cut it up, laminate it and comb bind into a booklet to preserve it for many years use. As it is my own, some parts may be photocopied to make the booklet more useful (such as keeping areas facing) in the booklet.

The map came in a timely way and was in great condition. However, it was easy to read only because most of the streets were removed so only the highways showed. I didn't understand that from the description listed on .

Love it! It's a standard size map with the west side of the state on one side, the east side of the state on the back side. So basically it's twice the size of your standard map. It is SO NICE to be able to actually read a map for a change!

This is a great, detailed map, except it is not all on one side. Western Washington on front, and Eastern Washington on the back...so, for instance, if you want to do the mountain loop from Highway 20 to Leavenworth, Wenatchee to Highway 2 you can't see the trip as a whole...so if you're doing only backyard travelling, this is the map for you.

This map is certainly easy to read, but it is also less useful. Instead of employing some good graphic design techniques to make the more important information more visible and cut clutter, the publisher decided to simply leave out any road smaller than a highway. That may be fine for a tourist passing through the state, but if you live here and want to navigate backroads where you don't have a cell signal (which is the whole point of a paper map these days), this map is not useful.

I purchased this Washington State map along with a book on the Washington State parks. Now we can look up parks to visit and find them too!

Great to have encase of emergency. Easy to read, has all main freeways/highways and main roads, but don't expect every dirt road to appear on this map. Good price and quality, as pictured. A little thicker when folded than I imagined but it is a pretty big decent map for the price.
