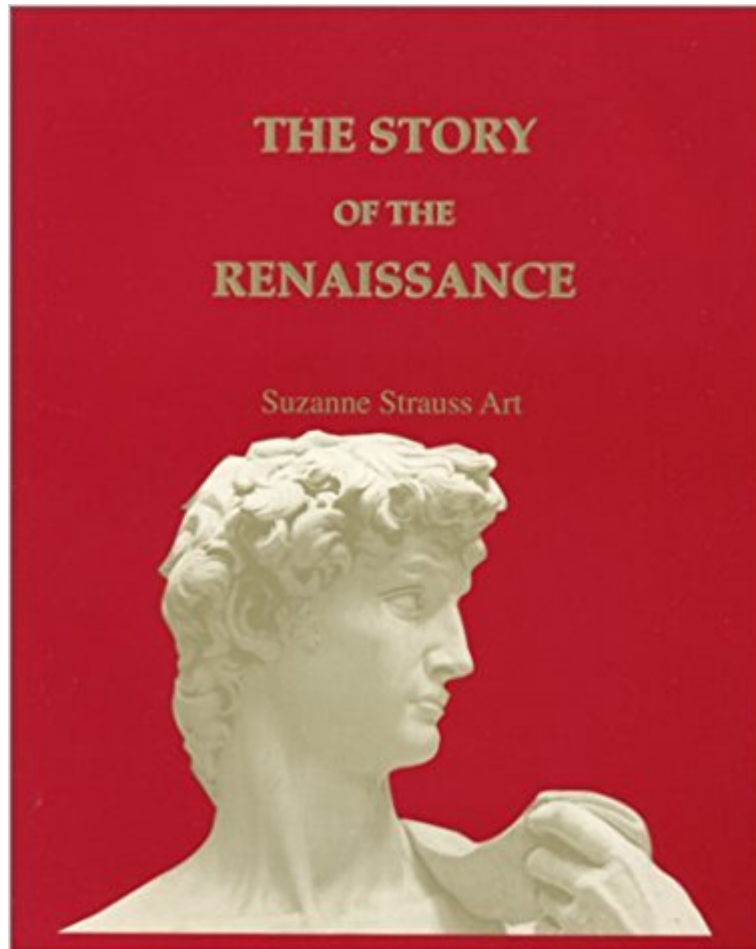




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Early Times: The Story Of The Renaissance

There are not many illustrations in the book either, the author for example says look at pictures in any other source and figure it out who is such and such person standing at the right! The book was intended for students of a course and is perfect for that purpose.
