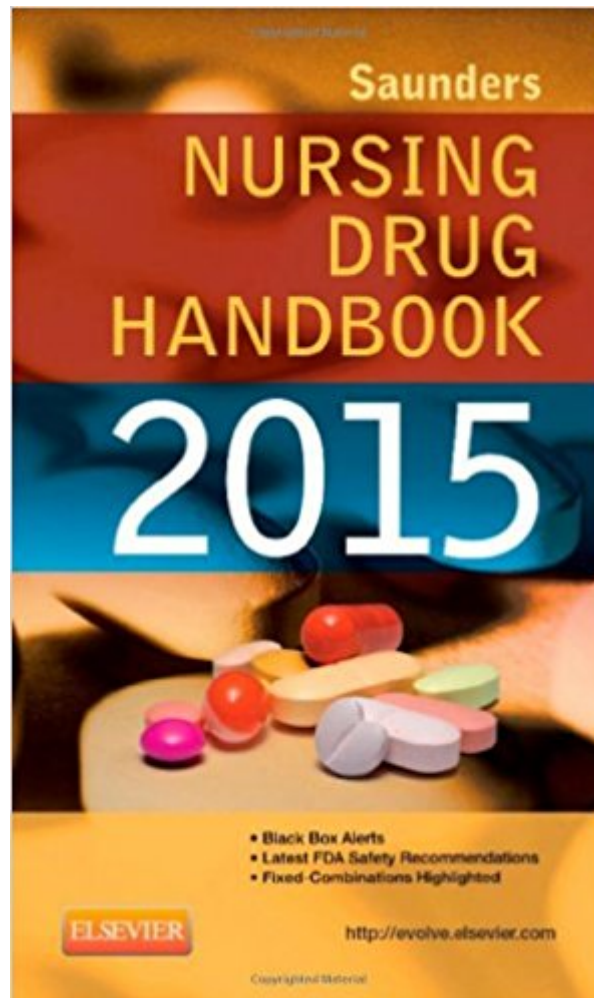

I bought this book for my 2nd year of nursing school and really wish I had it since day one. One day I started thumbing through some nursing books at Barnes and Noble and came across the drug guide section. I spent half an hour comparing all their options and found this one to be the best (for me). Our instructors always ask us the following questions: what's the drug for, drug class, what's the peak and onset, what are some common and serious side effects, is the dose ordered safe and therapeutic, is this drug compatible with existing fluids being run, etc. This is one of the few books I found that answers these questions clear and concisely (in my opinion). This book has a feature that lists common illnesses and groups all possible meds that may be used to treat them. So if you have a patient with high blood pressure, you can see 10 or so common meds you could expect to see him/her on for that illness. Another cool feature is the foldout compatibility chart in the first page of the book. Finally, I like the different appendix references in the back of the book: -Calculation of doses-controlled drugs-FDA pregnancy categories-chronic wound care (with staging)-drug abuse-equianalgesic dosing-herbals: common natural medicines-normal laboratory values-poison antidote chart-preventing med errors-parenteral fluid administration. I've read through most of these and found them to be very helpful. In conclusion, I think this drug book is awesome! The only thing it could use (I saw it in a different drug guide) would be some pictures of injection sites for subcutaneous, intramuscular, etc. Thanks!

I also appreciated the DO NOT CONFUSE WITH ... (listing drugs with similar names) portion of each medication's listing. The Black Box warnings were tremendously helpful. Easy to find what I was looking for, but the type is small. I'm glad I carry my glasses with me! It is a handy size though too thick to slip unobtrusively into a pocket.
