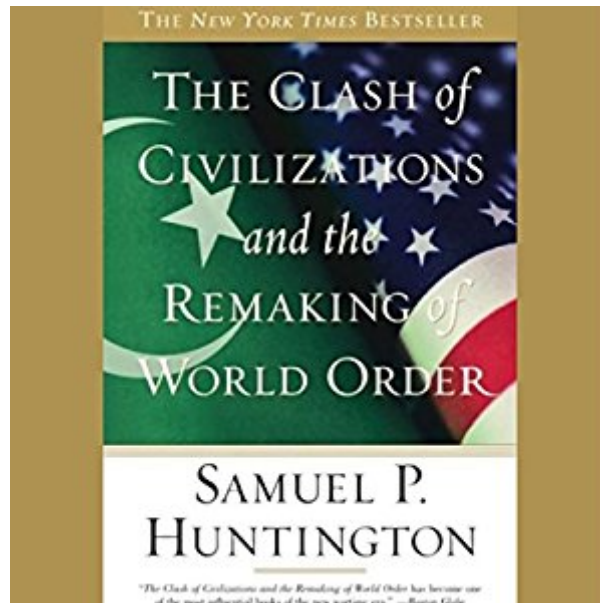




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The Clash Of Civilizations And The Remaking Of World Order

It does point out who are our enemies, in the sense that their culture is threatened by the Western (US is major part of the Western culture) idealism of every culture or civilizations should be like us, and add that if we protect our cultural identity and accept that other cultures can exist with their identity, the world could be a more peaceful world, by the elimination of war from the misunderstanding of other civilizations .

Prof. Huntington's thesis is perhaps the best explanation for what has been happening in the geopolitical world since the beginning of this Century. An every-increasing clash between the "Civilization" of Western Europe and America, on the one hand, and the "civilization" of the Islamic Middle Eastern World. Actually, this is merely the "reawakening" of a "clash of these two "Civilizations" that has been recurring in intensity ever since Mohammed appeared in the 7th Century. The frightening aspect is that the present "technologies" of war have developed to the point where an apocalyptic war that may result in the devastation of both of the warring societies and of much of mankind-- analogous to some Biblical Wars (cf., Deuteronomy) or to some of the Lord's demonstrations of disgust with mankind (Egyptian plagues, Sodom and Gomorrah)-- is possible if not likely some day.
