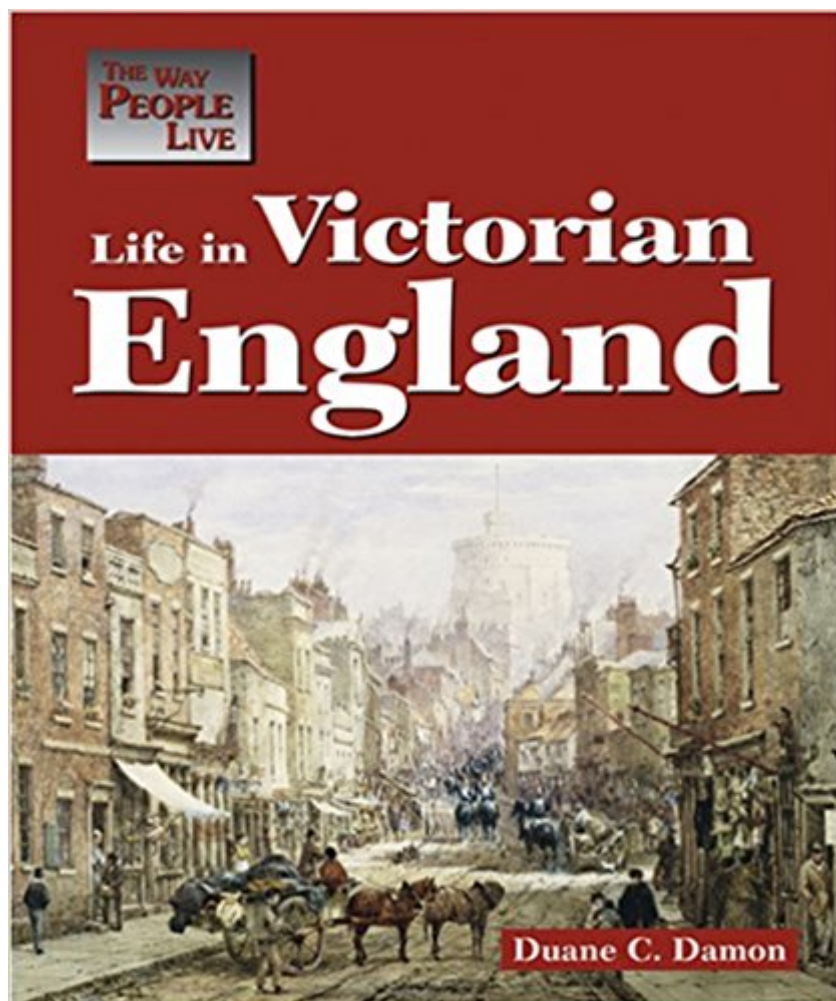

This volume covers Victoria's reign, the innovations of the Industrial Revolution, and the impact of the era's many changes on the lives of the people. Chapters address the quality of life for lower, middle, and aristocratic classes at work and at home, from the deplorable state of urban slums to the extravagant dinner parties of the upper crust. Additional topics include education reform, social life and courtship, leisure activities (particularly literature), and religion. Plentiful sidebars offer information on Diseases of the Slums, Tying the Knot, and The Rituals of Death. The black-and-white illustrations, maps, and photographs that appear on almost every spread make potentially dry content more accessible to visual learners. A broad variety of primary-source quotations and input from noted historians enhances the presentation. An extensive, annotated further-reading section leads researchers to Victorian novels (a nice touch), nonfiction books, Web sites, and videos. Make room for this report-ready, less-daunting title next to Sally Mitchell's *Daily Life in Victorian England* (Greenwood, 1996) and Daniel Pool's *What Jane Austen Ate and Charles Dickens Knew* (S & S, 1994).
